CPR is a combination of chest compressions and compression ventilation (mouth to mouth). Chest compressions manually pump the heart when it has stopped while compression ventilation inflates the victim's lungs. To administer chest compressions, link your fingers together, palms facing out and put the heel of your hand on the victim's breastbone.
